• As a Walk Leader, can I bring my own child(ren) on the WSB? We have several Walk Leaders who also have their own school-aged child participate on the Walking School Bus, or who have an infant who joins in a stroller. Please let us know in your application so we can figure out the specifics on a case-by-case basis.

- I'm only available for morning or afternoon walk shifts. Should I still apply? Absolutely. Our walks run mornings and afternoons, about an hour before and an hour after the school bell on all weekdays. We do have some schools running their WSB with a different AM and PM Walk Leader. Our ideal candidate is available for either all morning shifts, all afternoon shifts, or both. Let us know your availability in your application!
- Is training provided? Yes! We have both online and in-person training to make sure Walk Leaders are comfortable before jumping into the role.
- Do I need any special equipment? This role requires use of a personal smartphone, but otherwise all needed equipment is provided.
- I have an irregular schedule and can't join all the time, but would still love to help. What can I do? We are also hiring paid on-call Walk Leader positions for the Island, and are also always looking for volunteers to help out this community-based initiative! Otherwise, sharing this job posting with people you know who could be a good fit for the role is incredibly helpful.
