## Registration for Kindergarten

## Registering Children born in 2021

- 1. Is it the right time to register?
  - Early French Immersion (Kindergarten & Grade 1)
    - 2025-2026 School Year: You can still register your child at anytime during the current school year.
    - 2026-2027 School Year: Online registration for Early French Immersion opens at 8:00 am on January 12, 2026 and closes on January 16, 2026 at 3:30pm.
  - English Kindergarten
    - 2025-2026 School Year: You can still register your child at anytime during the current school year.
    - 2026-2027 School Year: Online registration for English Kindergarten opens at 8:00 am on January 26, 2026 and closes on January 30, 2026 at 3:30pm.

## 2. Do you know which school your child will attend based on your home address?

- Determining your catchment school is an easy and important step before you register
- Each home address within our District is associated with an elementary, middle and secondary school
- Visit the **School Locator Tool** and enter your residential address to find out which schools your child should attend

### 3. Do you meet the requirements?

- School-age eligibility: the child you are registering is <u>five years of age</u> by December 31st of the school year. Your child's eligibility is not based on their skillset, but is based on their age.
- Proof of citizenship: <u>one</u> of the following documents is required for your child:
  - Birth Certificate
  - Passport
  - Immigration Canada document
  - Certificate of Citizenship or Permanent Resident Card

• Proof of residential address: <u>two</u> different documents are required that provide proof of address

• 2026-2027 School Year: Online registration for Late French Immersion (Grade 6) opens at 8:00 am on January 26, 2026 and closes on January 30, 2026 at 3:30pm.
